## Telehealth Model Legislation

ERIC's Telehealth Initiative advocates for large employers' ability to offer telehealth services to their millions of employees, families, and retirees, so they can access quality health care – when and where they need it.

**ERIC encourages policymakers to develop telehealth laws and regulations which:**

- ❖ Specifically allow telehealth to establish a patient-provider relationship
- ❖ Apply the same standard of care to in-person visits and telehealth visits
- ❖ Do not require reimbursement for telehealth visits to be at the same rate as reimbursement for in-person visits
- ❖ Encourage interstate practice among providers
- ❖ Coordination between the patient's telemedicine provider and primary care provider is encouraged
- ❖ Simply define "telehealth" and "telemedicine" and apply the terms to broadly include all types of care that use technology to connect a provider in one location and a patient in a different location
- ❖ Does not require or encourage patients to travel to specific "originating sites" to access telehealth services
- ❖ Apply the same informed consent requirements to in-person visits and telehealth visits
- ❖ Allow prescribing via telemedicine
