Thank you for once again providing the opportunity for telehealth stakeholders to comment on your telemedicine proposal. As the only national trade association advocating solely for the benefit and compensation interests of America's largest employers, The ERISA Industry Committee (ERIC) speaks for the payer community on this issue.

As we have stated in our prior letters (see attached) to the Arkansas State Medical Board (ASMB), we support uniform, barrier-free access to telehealth. Our policy positions are designed to maintain a high standard of care without introducing unnecessary barriers to care.
